- Sunday Morning COW | April 23, 9:00 & 10:45 a.m.
 Your student will begin worship in the 45 Alive/Sunday School classroom
 where their elementary faith mentors will pray for them and their fellow
 students. After that the COW leaders will pick them up, so they can join the
 middle school class. Your student is invited to join the middle school
 program on Sunday mornings for the remainder of the school year and
 summer.
- Parent Meeting | Sunday April 23, 10:00 a.m. | Student Center
 Join Steve Noble, Pastor of Family Ministries, and Grace Stevenson in
 between worship services to learn more about what your student can
 expect in COW. You will hear more about Wednesday Night COW, COW
 Summer in the Park gatherings, and summer trips.
- COW Visit Night | Wednesday, April 26, 7:00–8:30 p.m. | Student Center
 - Fifth graders are invited to visit and explore our Wednesday night COW program. This is a one-time visit night, so that over the next few weeks we can celebrate and send off our graduating 8th graders.
- COW Worship Night | Wednesday, May 10, 7:00–8:15 p.m. | Auditorium
 Our community will throw our doors open wide for an extra big night of
 COW! This last gathering of the school year includes worship and tons of
 fun!

- No COW Sunday Programming | Sunday, May 14, 21, & 28
 During this short break of our regular programming we hope your family will worship together at our Classic or Contemporary services.
- COW Summer in the Park | Beginning Wednesday, June 7 | Central Park, Oak Brook Park District
 Incoming 6th graders are invited to participate in these evening large group gatherings. Amidst games and activities, students will have an opportunity to get to know some of their peers (Grades 6–8) and build friendships.
- Camp COW | June 26-June 30 | Baraboo, WI
 These five days are the best way for incoming 6th graders to make friends
 and feel most at home in the COW community. We hope and pray that your
 family's schedule will allow your student to join us. If it shows we are full,
