



Bless our local partners and the people they serve



■ ADMINISTER JUSTICE engages Christ followers to serve the legal and spiritual needs of the poor. Gospel Justice Centers are operated by local churches, where Christians provide legal assistance to members of their own communities. Christ Church operates a Gospel Justice Center at our Butterfield campus.

\$30 | Your gift covers the co-payment for a client needing legal advice who is unable to afford the fee.

■ Focused on a 40-block area in Garfield Park, BREAKTHROUGH partners with people to build connections, develop skills and open doors of opportunity. Breakthrough provides breakfast, lunch and dinner 365 days a year to individuals experiencing homelessness.

LAWNDALE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY CHURCH'S

mission is to redeem the Lawndale community by bringing Christian, holistic revitalization to the lives and environment of its residents through economic empowerment, housing improvement, educational enrichment, quality affordable health care and Christian discipleship. The Garden Summer Program is one of their oldest ministries. For more than 40 years, children Pre-K through grade 6 have enjoyed days filled with academics, physical activity, arts and crafts, studying God's Word and field trips.

Through training seminars, conferences, writers' workshops and publications NCUT mobilizes and equips Christian leaders. The Urban Alliance Center serves vulnerable populations, including widows who struggle to survive within the hierarchical society.

■ PHILIP and JILL ASPEGREN founded Casa Viva Costa Rica in 2003, which provides a safe place for children when they become separated from their families. Local families provide small, secure and specific solutions for children in need. Casa Viva collaborates with local churches and governments, Costa Rican donors and partners in the United States.

Not only do livestock supply families with food security by providing milk, protein and fertilizer for crops, but they also give families economic security. Goats and sheep can be sold at market and the profits support a family financially.

■ JEAN BAPTISTE MUGARURA serves with Youth for Christ Rwanda, a worldwide Christian movement working with young people around the globe. Motivated by faith in Jesus Christ, Youth for Christ shares the Good News with young people. Every year, more than 50,000 young people are reached and 1,600 evangelists trained in 24 local communities where Youth for Christ Rwanda is operating.

\$50 | Your gift provides meals and training materials for a week-long training session for youth disciplemakers.

■ In Asia, there are more than 25 million people without access to Christian resources. **PROJECT VIDEO** strives to develop a team in each culture that can make Christian resources in their own language. Video can be mass produced and passed around where evangelists cannot go. When people see these Gospel movies in their heart language, they realize that the Gospel has relevance to their culture. Project Video Gospel players are portable audio players that hold a range of audio media, including testimonies, worship songs, preaching and teaching segments. They are offered in any language and serve people groups that cannot read or write or have limited access to internet or other media resources.

■ MARK STOSCHER serves as director of Crossroads Torchbearers, which proclaims the transforming presence of Jesus Christ to the people of Albania through biblical teaching and practical training, equipping men and women for service in His church worldwide. Winters in Albania can be challenging for low-income families, particularly with the rising cost of fuel throughout Europe, Crossroads supports these communities.

\$20 | Your gift provides a coat for a child in the Crossroads program.

■ VIC and LESLIE TRAUTWEIN have been working with Kids Alive International in the Dominican Republic since 2002. Their work covers many areas in order to lift children spiritually, emotionally, mentally and physically. Most of the 1,900 students in seven Kids Alive schools live in impoverished conditions and can't afford dental care, which can lead to the loss of permanent teeth and a mouthful of trouble.

The Five Passions of Christ Church



We believe that God's goodness, beauty and truth can transform lives, neighborhoods, cities and the world. That's why Christ Church gives our time, talents and resources to advance the following FIVE CAUSES that we are most passionate about.

LIFTING WOMEN & CHILDREN

Jesus advocated for women and children in a time when few people did. As a result, we fund partners who work to protect kids and women from abuse; ensure that they are adequately fed, clothed, and cared for; and provide them with the spiritual and academic nurture that increases their health and hope, and draws them closer to God.

RELIEVING SUFFERING

The Gospel is about the "GOD Samaritan" who came to help people who are beaten, down in a ditch and without the resources to help themselves. Having experienced this grace from God, we are moved to offer relief to people who have been ravaged by crises and need practical help to get back on their feet.

MULTIPLYING CHURCHES & DISCIPLES


