Psalm 103:19-21

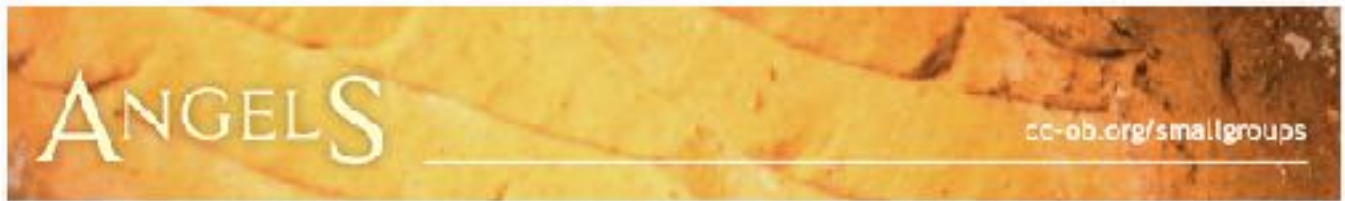
Open:

- Read Psalm 103:19-21 from two to three different translations of the Bible and share what intrigues, provokes, disturbs, challenges, encourages, warms, helps, or surprises you from this passage?
- From the message this weekend, what went through your heart and mind when you heard, “Psalm 103 teaches that the mission of angels is to do God’s bidding...to be obedient to his spoken word... to be the ministers that do his will. What that means is that where you and I are badly out of sync with God’s will, it will sometimes be the job of angels to disrupt our comfort, or challenge our preferences, or shake up our life.”
