WHEN | Sundays | During all services

Gather Sunday | Grades 1–5

Join us for games, activities, crafts, prizes, worship, a Bible lesson and a whole lot of fun. Signs will be posted on Gather Sundays to remind your children to go to Fellowship Hall. Please don't forget to check in at a kiosk. Invite a friend and bring your Bible. It is a Sunday you will not want to miss.

Family Worship | Child Care Only

There are several Sundays throughout the school year when we encourage families to worship together to give our volunteers a break from teaching.
