

STUDENT MINISTRY

COVID CODE OF CONDUCT:

Temperature Checks:

- 1.) Temperature Checks will be required to check in at student gatherings.

Masks:

- 1.) Masks will be worn at all times while attending a student ministry gathering.
- 2.) Masks will remain on before and after gatherings while still on Christ Church property or at the location of a Christ Church sanctioned event.
- 3.) Masks must cover both mouth and nose at all times.

Distancing:

- 1.) Students and staff will always maintain 6 feet of social distancing from one another.
- 2.) Distancing will be maintained both before and after gatherings while still on Christ Church property or at the location of a Christ Church sanctioned event.

Bathrooms:

- 1.) During Small group gatherings at the church, bathrooms will be closed to student use.
- 2.) During Large group gatherings at the church, students will be permitted to use the restroom one at a time and will be escorted by a staff person to the bathroom entrance.

Building Use:

- 1.) Students will be assigned specific rooms throughout the building, and will follow specific paths to enter and exit the church.
- 2.) Students will not be permitted to wander the building, or use the water fountain.

Food and Drink:

- 1.) No food or drink will be permitted at any of the student ministry on campus or off campus gatherings. We ask that you refrain from bringing water bottles, snacks or other food items as we seek to maintain a consistent approach in enforcing our mask policy.

Enforcement:

- 1.) Students will be on a 3 strike system for accidental violation of these policies and zero tolerance for intentional violation of these policies.
- 2.) In the case that discipline is necessary, students will be asked to leave the gathering, and will be unable to return until Christ Church Staff has met with the offender and their parents and determined that the student is prepared to adhere to the necessary policies.

In The Case of Exposure:

- 1.) If a student is confirmed to have COVID, or has had exposure to someone who is confirmed to have COVID, we ask that the parents immediately contact a staff representative to make them aware of the exposure.
- 2.) We will then alert all groups of the potential exposure (omitting names for obvious reason). Additionally we will move the impacted small group to Zoom gatherings until the potential exposure has been resolved.
