RECEIVE

- Prayerfully recite the Apostles' Creed.
- Focus Section: I believe...in the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting.
- Read 1 Corinthians 15; Revelation 21:1-7

REFLECT

- Provide 10 minutes of silence to read or listen to 1 Corinthians 15. Then have someone read or listen to 1 Corinthians 15 in *The Message* version.
- What key phrases or imagery especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, helped or surprised you? Why?
- What does it meant to believe the Gospel in vain?
- Why did Paul emphasize the facts of Christ's resurrection?
- What does it mean for you to hold firmly to the Gospel? Be as specific and practical as possible.
- How does the resurrection of Jesus shape your living?
- How do you hope the resurrection of Jesus to shape your death to come? (I know, I know—an unusual question but one the text leads us to reflect on.)
- How can we as followers of Jesus, grieve for a loved one's death yet still hold on to the hope of resurrection?

RESPOND

- Have someone read Revelation 21:1-7, then play the song, <u>I Can Only Imagine</u>, by Mercy Me.
- After you listen, share what is stirring through your heart and mind...what do you imagine of the redeemed life to come with Jesus?
