CONSTRUCTION UPDATE | Work is underway on the new Student Center and classrooms! Pardon our dust as we update and expand our children's classrooms and middle and high school student areas, create a sensory room and relocate Family Ministry offices.

We are doing our best to keep interruptions to a minimum but some families will experience temporary room changes in this next season.

Here is some of what has been completed recently:

- Corridors connecting the Discovery Center to the Preschool hallways on both the upper and lower levels were completed in December. With these changes we've improved security and made it easier for families to move through our spaces.
- The roof over the 260s wing of the building has been replaced, eliminating leaks in that corridor.
- New chairs were in place in our Butterfield campus Auditorium for Christmas Eve! This is a fabulous update for our worship space.

GOATS were gifted to vulnerable families in Kenya as part of FOR Christmas. In total, \$82,309 was given to support 18 domestic and global mission partners. In addition, the congregation provided 1,270 PRESENTS to donate to children and families across 8 mission partners.
