- What did you hear from Aaron's message that you learned or that you heard for the first time?
- What is the idea of Biblical Justice? (hint: recognizing the Image of God in everyone and seeking that they are treated that way!)
- Where do you see actual biblical justice carried out in your life?
- Describe your typical perspective toward the marginalized, if you're comfortable! (e.g 1) I have a hard time seeing the marginalized, 2) I see the injustice, but it doesn't really affect me, 3) I see their pain, and my heart breaks for them, but what can I do?, etc)
- How might focusing on the individuals that are experiencing injustice (rather than the issue) help us change our mindest to see them and act justly toward them? (Who vs What)

- As a group, make a list of the injustices you see in the world at large. Where are people being treated as less than they are?
- Which of those in the list do your hearts break for most?
- What does it look like to care for, "have regard for", those individuals – even if they are across the world?
 - -Learning about their experiences
 - -Praying for them, mourning with them
 - -Looking into how the church can support them
 - -Share their stories
- Think specifically about your week ahead. As a small group, how can you care for people experiencing injustice across the world this week?
