- 8. How do you feel about being part of the solution as a worker in the messiness?

**Respond** | Encouraged forward by Jesus, pray these words throughout the coming week:

Lord Jesus in the midst of my own messiness, may You give me the eyes to see what You see. The ears to hear what You hear. A heart to be moved as Yours is moved and hands that are ready to serve others in the midst of their messy lives.
