

Project Video works to proclaim the Gospel to the 2.7 billion people in Asia who are completely "unreached" by Christianity. Leveraging the portability of audio/visual media, Project Video brings the Good News to remote areas of the world where Bibles and Christian resources are unavailable, much of the population is illiterate, and the name "Jesus" has never been heard before.

Project Video trains and equips believers in remote areas to create their own Christian videos and audio Bibles. Donating equipment and building production studios, "PV" then teaches the local teams to create and spread Christian content. Thus, indigenous leaders can share God's word with unreached people, in their own language and context, in places where missioniaries are unlikely to go.
