Due to the fluid nature of COVID-19 and the CDC's recommendations, these guidelines are subject to change prior to (Vacation Bible School) VBS. We will be sure to alert everyone of any changes as we get closer to VBS.

- To ensure we are creating a safe environment for your child in-person, we will be asking everyone to follow the latest health and safety protocols.
 - Children will be asked to wear a mask and to use hand sanitizer.
 - Children will be encouraged to social distance throughout their time in accordance to current CDC guidelines.
- We have do our best to ensure we are creating a safe environment for all who attend.
 - The children will be assigned to groups for the week, where they will spend a majority of their time together.
 - VBS stations will be outdoors or in large volume indoor spaces.
 - We will have our amazing large group session that will take place outside where groups are safely distanced to gather together.
 - If we experience inclement weather, all our outside group activities and programming will be moved inside.
 Weather related decisions will be made prior to the start of the event and all parents will be notified.
- If any child/volunteer or family member of the individual registered for VBS has been exposed or is experiencing COVID or COVID-like symptoms we ask they refrain from attending VBS for the safety of all who are serving and attending VBS. We will offer a full refund to anyone who needs to cancel due to COVID related issues.
