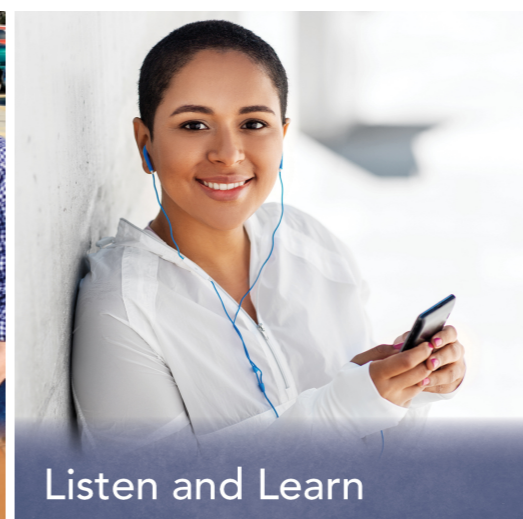

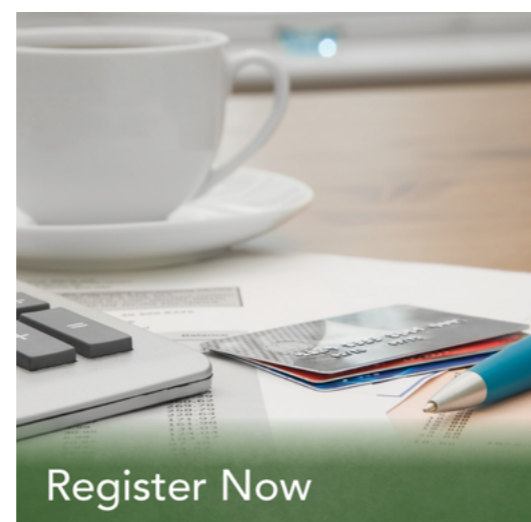

## Enjoy hymns, spirituals, classical & more

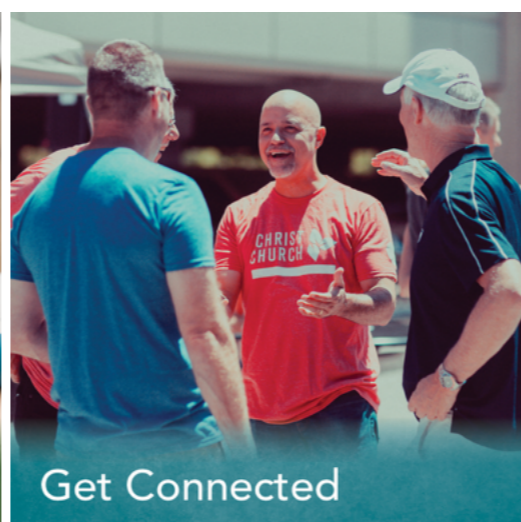

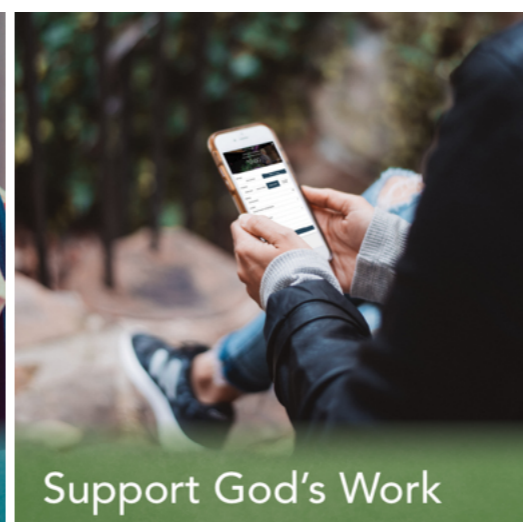
