

REALLY? The Radical Call & Reluctant Enlistment of Moses

REFLECT | Week 2 | Exodus 3–4

- Moses went from living in a lavish palace to herding sheep. What do you think God was teaching Moses? Have you ever been through a humbling and refining season of preparation?
- 2. Identify the specific questions Moses asked God in 3:11; 3:13, & 4:1. How do these questions still show up in modern life? Do you engage with or hide from questions like these? Where do you find answers?
- 3. What stands out to you about the way God responds to Moses' questions?
- 4. Based on verses 4:10 & 4:13, what was Moses really doing with his questions? Do you do the same?
- 5. What do you think about God's response (4:14) to Moses? What does this trigger in you?
- 6. What motivates your worship of God? How do you express your love and appreciation to God?

How will I step beyond my excuses to trust God?
