REFLECT | Week 7 | Exodus 19:1-7

- 1. Exodus 19 is a transition from what God has done to what God plans to do. Think back on these past few chapters. What has God done for the people of Israel?
- 2. Read Exodus 19:1–7 as if you were one of the elders mentioned. What is going through your head and heart as your listen to Moses sharing with you?
- 3. Do you feel like God treasures you in a similar way? How do these words strike you?
- 4. How does verse 19:4 make verse 19:5 possible? Does knowing you are accepted and loved help you to demonstrate love back to God and others?
- 5. What does God mean when He says He carried them on eagles' wings? See Isaiah 40:31.
- 6. Based on 19:5–6 what does God intend for the people of Israel?
